

Pathshala: Things to remember!!

1. Punctuality is important and to be fair to children who are punctual.
 - Students should come **7:00 PM** for the prayer and will not be allowed in class after 07:15PM.
2. Dress Code: Appropriate (similar to what you wear for Temple) clothing for Pathshala
3. **60% attendance** by each student is required because
 - Teachers spend considerable time in preparation for the classes
 - Students' absence disrupts the planned curriculum for the entire class
 - If student missed the class, parents need to cover up at home
 - If you miss two or more consecutive classes, let the teacher know the reason for the absences once you have returned to class.
4. **Exam days are Mandatory**, if it is genuine reason inform teacher in advance!
5. There will be **2 field trips** (temple visit) in a year, which is mandatory to attend for path Shala student.
6. Please check all Pathshala related e-mails on a regular basis.
7. Always send books/notepad/pen/pencil to the class
8. The student will be cooperative with everyone and show respect to each student regardless of age.
9. Parents are not allowed to sit in the classroom; however parents of kids must stay in the Pathshala building at all times during a Pathshala session (**in Swadhyay class**).
10. Each student must complete all homework assignments and bring it to class to submit to the teacher regularly. If the child is unable to complete the assignment or needs help, parent should personally notify the teacher and ask for help or himself/herself assist the child finish the assignment.
11. It is the responsibility of the parents and the student to contact teacher/s and collect all material as well as assignments for any missed class.
12. The students will respect the right of others and will not use loud voices. Do not disturb any class that is in session and maintain silence in the temple.
13. Running or horseplay is not allowed inside the building
14. Chewing gum, eating or drinking or use of cellphone (texting) is not allowed during class.
15. The teacher may insist on proper sitting manners and behavior during class.
